Dear Mr. Wolak,

This letter by the Board of Doctors' Trade Union of Poland (OZZL) is to express solidarity with the doctors' trade union in Slovakia (LOZ) as well as with doctor Peter Blasko, a member of the board of LOZ, whose employment at the hospital in Žilina has been recently terminated. The circumstances of this termination demonstrate that it was nothing more but an illegal attempt to remove a union doctor in order to send a warning message to his colleagues who exercise their statutory labor rights to protest. Such actions constitute a flagrant violation of the fundamental labor and civil rights and are unknown to any other democratic state. Only under totalitarianism citizens and workers are regarded as a property of the state which can force them to perform its own will.


